In an effort to strengthen patient and staff safety, Genesis HealthCare is implementing a Universal Influenza Vaccination Program this fall. Over 36,000 people die annually from influenza, and 226,000 are hospitalized. Children and the elderly are especially at risk. Because of this, annual vaccination will be encouraged for all **Genesis staff—including agency registrants.**

All registrants who choose to be vaccinated will need to provide proof of vaccination

1. Registrants who choose **NOT** to be vaccinated will be required to wear a center-provided mask for the duration of the **flu season (November – March 2019)** Masks must be worn in all areas of the center except the break room.
2. Any registrant without an appropriate document uploaded will be made inactivated until the situation is remedied.
3. If a registrant chooses to use documentation other than the form we provide as their proof of vaccination, that document must include the following:

Employee's first and last name

Date completed

Manufacturer of vaccine

Lot number

Expiration date of vial used

Type of vaccine given

Placement location

Name/signature of administering clinician
